### **Basquiat-Inspired Art Making ●●**

Basquiat combined text and images in a raw expressionist style to explore culture and society through historical and popular themes. As in his paintings, fragments of found texts appear throughout the notebooks, incorporating street signage, news stories, and references from literature and the Old Testament.

### **Eric Carle Story Times ●**

Hear some of Eric Carle's treasured stories read aloud, including *Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?*, *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, and *The Grouchy Ladybug*.

### **Eric Carle-Inspired Art Making ●**

To create the collages that illustrate his books, Carle paints white tissue papers with acrylics to achieve the vibrant colors and patterns he desires. He then cuts and tears the papers and adheres the different shapes onto illustrations. Follow his technique as you create your own collages!

### **Fam Jam with Dave Holland & Beatin' Path Rhythm ●**

You will have a blast playing along in one of our interactive Fam Jams! Parents and kids will be provided a drum or rhythm instrument and as a group, you will be guided through an "in the moment" musical experience. No experience is needed! (best for ages 2+)

### **"Life Doesn't Frighten Me"—Movement-Based Story Times ●●**

T. Lang, Assistant Professor of Drama and Dance at Spelman College and Director of Spelman Dance Theatre, worked with her students to interpret the book *Life Doesn't Frighten Me*, in which Maya Angelou's strong words are matched by the daring vision of artist Jean-Michel Basquiat. Together, Angelou's words and Basquiat's paintings create a place where every child or adult may experience his or her own fearlessness.
